

## **GYNAECOLOGICAL PROCEDURES AND FLUOROSCOPY**

### **HSG/HYSTEROSALPINGOGRAPHY**

This is an x-ray to see if the fallopian tubes/tubes are blocked or not and involve the use of Contrast Agents.

Contrast Agents are special drugs which show body organs on the X-Rays.

If you have any allergies contact us before hand .

1. Purchase two (2) Dulcolax tablets and a douche Kit from the Pharmacy.
2. Take the two Dulcolax tablets at 4 p.m. the evening before the procedure.
3. Read the douche kit instructions carefully and use it on the morning of the procedure.
4. Have nothing to eat 4 hours before the procedure.
5. You may have one cup of coffee, tea or juice 4 hours before.

### **HSS/HYSTEROSONOGRAM**

This is an ultrasound examination to see the lining (Endometrium) of the uterus.

The preparation is the same as for HSG.

### **FLUOROSCOPY PROCEDURES**

This is the use of X-Rays to view organs in the body and may involve the use of Contrast Agents (see HSG explanation) .

Inform us if you have any allergies.

Nothing to eat or drink 4 hours before the examination.
